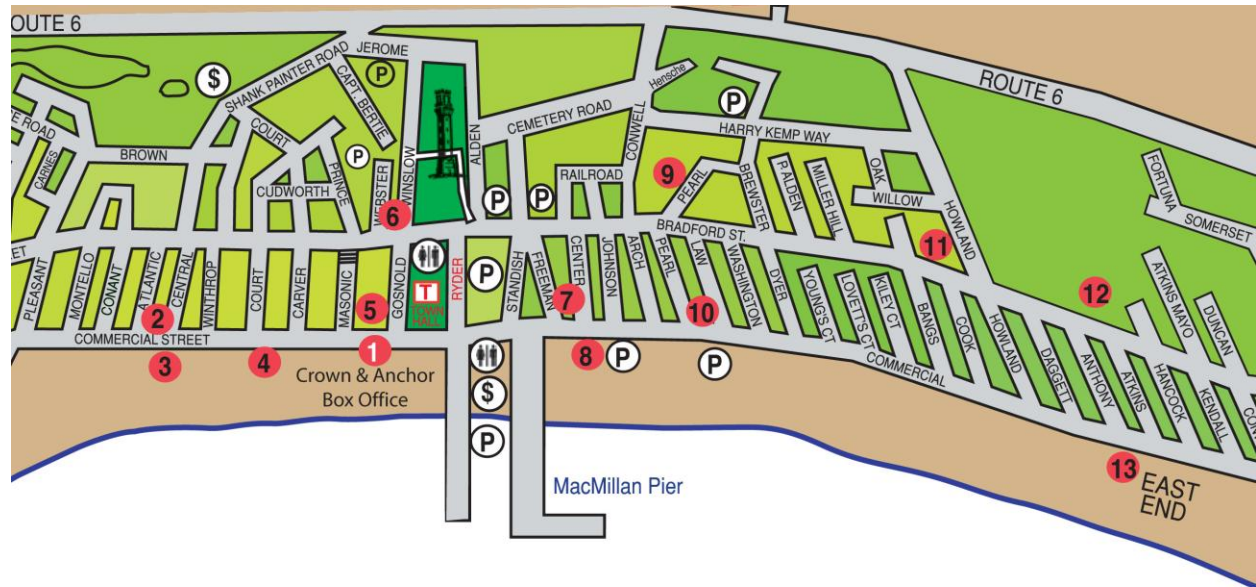




Festival Parking

Closest to the box office: The town's main parking lot is close to the Crown & Anchor, located at the base of MacMillan Pier, just off Commercial Street. For current parking rates call 508.487.7050.

Overnight Parking: Duarte's, which is in the center of town on Bradford Street (between Center and Freeman), offers overnight parking and can accommodate over-sized vehicles. 508.487.0113.

Street Parking: Parking on the street is carefully marked – be sure to obey painted street markings and posted signs.

Meter Parking: Municipal parking lots in the West End, spaces near Town Hall, and the lot at Johnson Street have meters for public use.
